# What is Seminar Program?



## [Purpose]

- 1) Foster and encourage the Association members to maintain and develop relationships with researchers in Japan
- 2) Organize events that enhance communication among the Association members and with researchers in Japan
- 3) Support other academic activities initiated by the Association members

## [Applicable Research Fields]

Any fields of humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences.

\*JSPS does not support subjects related to military / defense research

# What is Seminar Program?

## [Eligibility Requirements]

- Regular member of US & Canada Alumni Association
- Researcher affiliated with a research organization in the US or Canada



### **Regular Member:**

Persons who have been funded and/or awarded by JSPS and currently residing or have an affiliation with a research organization in the U.S. or Canada are eligible for regular membership.

# Seminar Program FY 2024

Application Deadline	<b>April 30, 2024</b>
Number of Awardees	<b>2 seminars</b>
Seminar Venue	US or Canada
Seminar Date	<b>between August 2024 and January 2025</b>
Speaker	At least one researcher from Japan as a speaker and/ or discussant
Other requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The seminar should include information session open to university /institute</li><li>• <b>Should not be a closed meeting among particular research groups</b></li></ul>

# Seminar Program FY 2024

## [Invited Speaker from Japan]

The invited researcher from Japan must be a full-time researcher affiliated with university and research institution in Japan, meet the eligibility to apply for a Grant-Aid for Scientific Research, "KAKENHI."



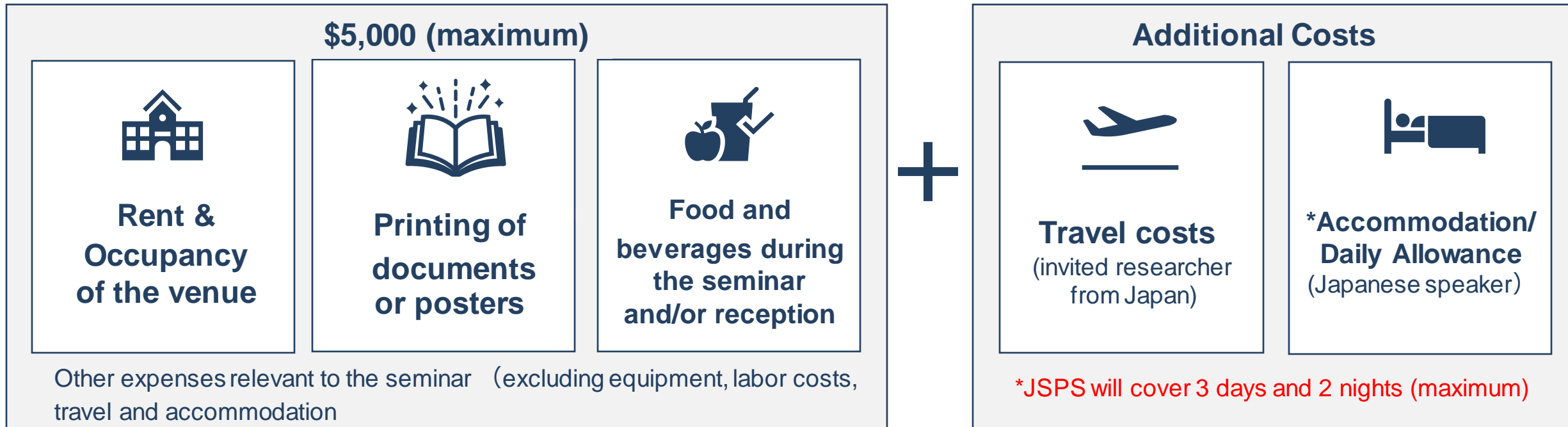
### **Requirements for KAKENHI application:**

KAKENHI is one of the grant-aids provided by JSPS. Researchers who belong to universities, research institutions of private corporations or other organizations designated by MEXT Minister may apply for KAKENHI grants.

# Amount of Funding

One seminar will have a maximum funding level of **\$5,000 (USD) other than costs for a Japanese researcher.**



- It can be combined with another funding source, but please be careful not to overlap.
- The cost of food and beverage should not exceed 50% of total support from JSPS or \$2,000 (USD), whichever is higher.
